This course will provide you with a knowledge update and better understanding of the impact of parental mental health on children and practical information on how best we can support them.

The course will also focus on the highly effective CUMI Programmes (Children Understanding Mental Illness) which Bernadette has developed in New Zealand. These psycho-educational programmes use different forms of media to help children of different age groups come to terms with a mentally ill family member. The programmes provide children with information about their parent's illness, myths and facts, what they can expect to see, how they can expect themselves to feel and how they can get help for themselves. As well as dealing with their questions about how people get mental illnesses, their worries about whether they can expect to get this themselves and the self-esteem problems that seem to be common amongst these children. Participants will be given the opportunity to try some of the games used in the CUMI programmes to help the children learn.

The course will be taught through a lively mix of presentation, scenarios, case studies and discussion to ensure your learning is interesting and informative.
